



# George Mougolias Memorial Foundation 2018 Scholarship Application

*The purpose of these scholarships is not solely for financial assistance for the recipients but also to keep George Mougolias' spirit alive in the Hellenic community. This will be accomplished by awarding \$1,000-\$1,500 scholarships to the applicants deemed most worthy based on the following requirements.*

## Eligibility Requirements

1. All applicants must be Greek Orthodox.
2. All applicants must have maintained a minimum of a B average (3.00 on a 4.00 system) during his/her entire high school course of study.
3. The applicant must have applied to an accredited four-year university.
4. For additional consideration based on need, attach a copy of your Pell Grant award letter or an Illinois State Assistance letter.
5. Application must be submitted no later than **April 13, 2018**.
6. This application must be signed at the space provided at the bottom of the page.
7. In order for the applications to be complete, it must be accompanied by:
  - A.) An official transcript of grades from the high school of the applicant.
  - B.) Two (2) completed recommendation forms. These recommendations can be completed by anyone chosen by the applicant so long as they can attest to the applicant's leadership qualities. It is up to the applicant to make sure that all of these recommendations are submitted by the deadline date.
  - C.) A certified copy of the results on either the ACT or SAT. The test score will not be required if it is noted on official transcripts.
